THE PROJECT

1. Project background (introduction of the project)

Kapuas Hulu has high valued-biodiversity forests including its wildlife. There are few rare and endemic species in this area, such as Rhinoceros hornbill, Proboscis Monkey, Cicotonia Stormi, Tomistoma, Super red dragonfish, etc. These species are listed in Level 1 Appendix Cites. These species go through endangered because of massive deforestation, illegal trafficking, and sometimes just hunted for consume.

KOMPAKH believes that forest has to be guarded as a crucial element of earth. From the beginning, forest serves local communities's need : food, clean water, wood, medicine, cosmetic, and many other living needs. According to many genuine local tradition, forest is the main element in their whole life. It is their pride.

Now, although lots of local people leave forest as a direct source, it is still being very important for them. The protection of forest is an incumbency of all generation. Not just an obligation to adults and local but kids and teenagers all over the world have the same right to protect forest. Moreover, the awareness of nature, inclusively forest and its widelife, would be deep embedded since someone being young. And this is why this programme highly recommended.

The planned activities designed to attract and implicate as many as Kapuas Hulu's kids and teenagers, especially from Putussibau. Let us hope that through this programme there will be many kids and teenagers to be pride to guard of their forest and recognise why do they have to help maintain forest sustainability.

2. Project location

3. Project duration

(1) One year (twelve months)

4. Strategy (Goal and Objective of the project)

Goal : To implicate the awareness of forest sustainability at kids and teenagers level as next generation

Objectives :

1. Creating passion to the young generation about the importance of forest and species protection.
2. Presenting the local knowlegde and local wisdom related to the protection of the ecosystem to raise the understading of the young
3. Creating the teen conservationist to ttrenghen the protection of the wildlife in Kapuas Hulu

5. Expected result of the project

1. Young generation that recognise and pride of their priceless forest and traditional wisdom
2. Young generation will be act as an agent of protecting endemic and extinct animals

3. The existence of endemic and rare species will be recognised widely

5. Expected problem of the project (social cases)

1. There is no support from those who are doing wildlife hunting and illegal trafficking
2. There are safety risks to involve young people to do outdoor activity

6. Project contribution expected:

- a. For the environment

Widely recognition of Kapuas Hulu's rich biodiversity will cause more people to try to protect it.

- b. For the people;

The implementing of forest protection will keep the environment in a better condition. The good condition of the environment will deliver good service to human being.

- c. For the district development

Help local government to campaign Kapuas Hulu as a Conservation District, fitting the decree of Kapuas Hulu as a Conservation District at 2003 and Kapuas Hulu as the Heart of Borneo (HoB) main area.

7. Project sustainability

There will be a young people community (*Kapuas Hulu Junior Ranger Community*) that helps to continue promoting and encouraging people to conserve the forest and endemic species in Kapuas Hulu district level.

8. Budget estimation

Subproject 1. Junior Ranger

Endemic Species Drawing Contest, involving at least 100 primary school students and 100 junior high school students (mix from inside and outside Putussibau City). The budget is 35.500.000 IDR (around 2840 EUR)

Subproject 2. Teen Ranger

Orangutan Monitoring's Route Camp and Trek. Activity involving around 20 Junior High School students (mix from inside and outside Putussibau). In its activity the students will be presented the way of conservationist protect the forest. The suitable area is in Melemba Village, which only can be accessed by cruising Sentarum Lake's buffer zone. The activity is designed to build their awareness, passion, and pride of their jungle. For example, the kids would do trekking in Orangutan Monitoring's Route during learn how the professional and local people do it, etc. The budget estimation to this project is not less than 45,000,000 IDR.

Subproject 3. Youth Ranger

Conservation Debate Contest For Youth, involving 50 Senior High School (mix from inside and outside Putussibau). The budget is 13.850.000 IDR (around 1108 EUR)
